JAAL in JACET Proceedings (hereafter, the Proceedings) is the collection of manuscripts about oral presentations which are going to be given at the JAAL in JACET 2024. The manuscripts are not going to be peer-reviewed.

*If a presenter cannot meet the deadline, their manuscript(s) will not be published in the Proceedings.

A. Editorial Policy

1. Manuscripts which do not conform to the guidelines will not be considered for publication.
2. Manuscripts need to be submitted in the form of a PDF file. As a general rule, the Editorial Board of the Proceedings will not change the submitted manuscripts.
3. Paper offprints will not be provided. The Proceedings is an electronic record of the JAAL in JACET 2024.

B. Guidelines

1. Manuscripts should be written using the template provided by the Editorial Board.
2. Manuscripts on A4 paper, including title, abstract, figures, tables, acknowledgments, references and appendix, should be written within 2 pages in a two-column format. Authors of invited presentations are entitled to write their manuscripts within 2–4 pages in a two-column format.
3. All manuscripts must be written in English or Japanese, the language used in the oral presentation given at the JAAL in JACET 2024.
4. Submit your paper in the form of a PDF file, saving them under the first author's full name as in the following examples: Jamie Roy Cooper (i.e. your name).

C. Contributors' Responsibility

1. Contributors are responsible for the content of their manuscripts.
2. Contributors are responsible for obtaining permission to reproduce any material such as figures

and tables for which they do not own the copyright, and for ensuring that the appropriate acknowledgements are included in their manuscript.

D. Copyright

1. JACET holds the copyright of the Proceedings.
2. Anyone, including the author(s), who wishes to reproduce or republish a manuscript, must obtain permission from JACET. Also, it should be clearly stated that JACET holds the copyright.
