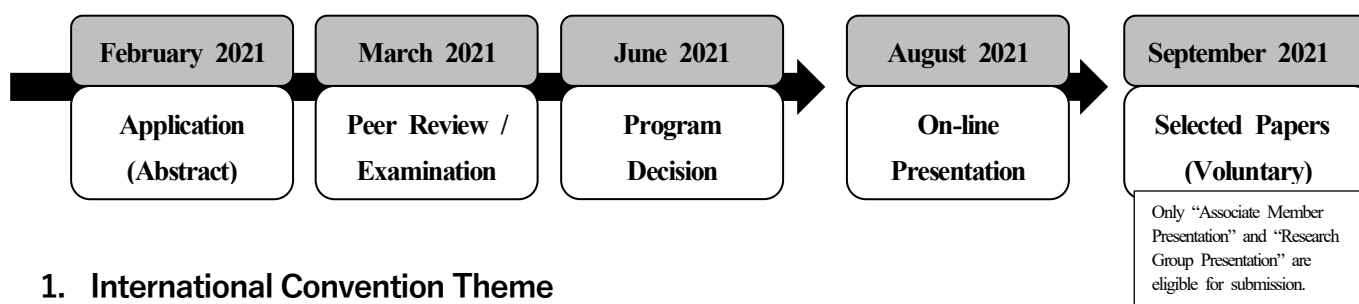


Japan Association of College English Teachers (JACET) 60th Commemorative International Convention (Online, 2021) “JACET Hours” Presentation Application Procedures

2022 marks the 60th anniversary of the Japan Association of College English Teachers (JACET). Its 48th Summer Seminar and 60th Commemorative International Convention will be held as a joint online conference during the JACET 60th Anniversary Commemoration Week from August 25 (Wednesday) to August 29 (Sunday), 2021. Information pertaining to general presentations (research presentations and practical reports) by either JACET members or non-members on days 4 and 5 of the Commemorative Week (August 28 and 29) has been announced separately. In addition to these opportunities, however, we would like to invite JACET members to present in the morning of Day 3 of the Commemorative Week (August 27) during “JACET Hours.” In “JACET Hours” we ask members to take advantage of the online nature of the event to deliver a broad range of presentations about ongoing research results, teaching practices, or Chapter activities. We created this time with the sincere hope that JACET members will mobilize their energies to liven up the Commemorative Week. We eagerly await applications from many members.



1. International Convention Theme

“English Language Education to Endure Changing Times: Facing the Reality of Society 5.0”

2. “JACET Hours” Presentation Date

AM slots only on Friday, August 27, 2021.

3. Presentation Types

- (1) ~~Associate Member Presentation (30 min.): Presentations focused on university English education. (End of application)~~
- (2) ~~Research Group Presentation (90 min.): Symposiums discussing research content or workshops addressing a particular issue. (End of application)~~
- (3) SIG Poster Presentation (60 min.): Presentations which discuss the work of a particular SIG.
- (4) Chapter Organized Presentation (90 min.): Symposiums or workshops by a chapter’s members discussing “Ideas for Online Learning for Tomorrow’s Class.”

4. Application requirements

- (1) The first presenter must be a member of JACET.
- (2) Submissions for the above-noted Associate Member Presentation and Research Group Presentation will need to be approved through peer review and examination.

5. Presentation Format

- (1) Online synchronous presentations, including Q and A.
- (2) Delivered in English or Japanese.
- (3) In principle, presenters will be responsible for the operation of Zoom and for hosting/running their session. (Zoom login information should be submitted in the middle of June 2021).

Note: Abstracts for “JACET Hours” presentations will be listed in the digital convention handbook. They cannot be submitted for publication in the Proceedings.

6. Application Procedure

Abstracts can be a maximum of 300 words in English or 800 characters in Japanese and, along with author information, must

7. Submission Period

February 1, 2021 (Monday) – **March 27, 2021 (Saturday) 23:59:59 JST**

8. Selection of Abstracts

- (1) Corresponding authors will receive an email notification regarding the status of their application towards the end of March 2021.
- (2) The program and time schedule for “JACET Hours” will be announced at the beginning of June 2021.

9. JACET International Convention Selected Papers (Vol. 8)

Presenters are encouraged to submit a paper for consideration for publication in the 2021 volume of *JACET International Convention Selected Papers*. Submission guidelines will be announced later. **Only “Associate Member Presentation” and “Research Group Presentation” are eligible for submission.**
