 - 4) Experience of English teaching at university level.
 - 5) At least three publications in the field of English Teaching (TESOL), applied linguistics, or in an academic field related to North American culture and society.
 - 6) Sufficient Japanese proficiency to perform education and administration-related work (participating in meetings, drafting documents, entrance exam-related duties, etc.).
 - 7) Knowledge or research interests on North America, or experience in teaching about the region, is not a requirement but an advantage.
 - 8) Willing to reside in the Kinki area after hiring.
